Comment:

The commenter states the view that eliminating the requirement to report to ICE would be unlawful and inconsistent with constitutional requirements.

Agency Response:

Oregon DOC complies with all state laws regarding information sharing with federal immigration authorities. These laws generally prohibit sharing immigration information with federal law enforcement agencies for the purpose of civil immigration enforcement.
