Dear Mr. Spear:

This letter is in regard to an exposure of rock on property owned by Mr. and Mrs. Lee Person located primarily in section 8, Township 2 south, Range 8 west.

The area appears to contain good quality road material typical of the Columbia River basalt found in the quarry a short distance to the south formerly operated by C. C. Meisel.

Features favorable to using this rock are as follows.

1. Quality is superb.
2. Dice rock fracturing makes it economical to crush.
3. Overburden is thin in this area.
4. The site is not visible from a well traveled road.
5. The area is central to places of intended use.

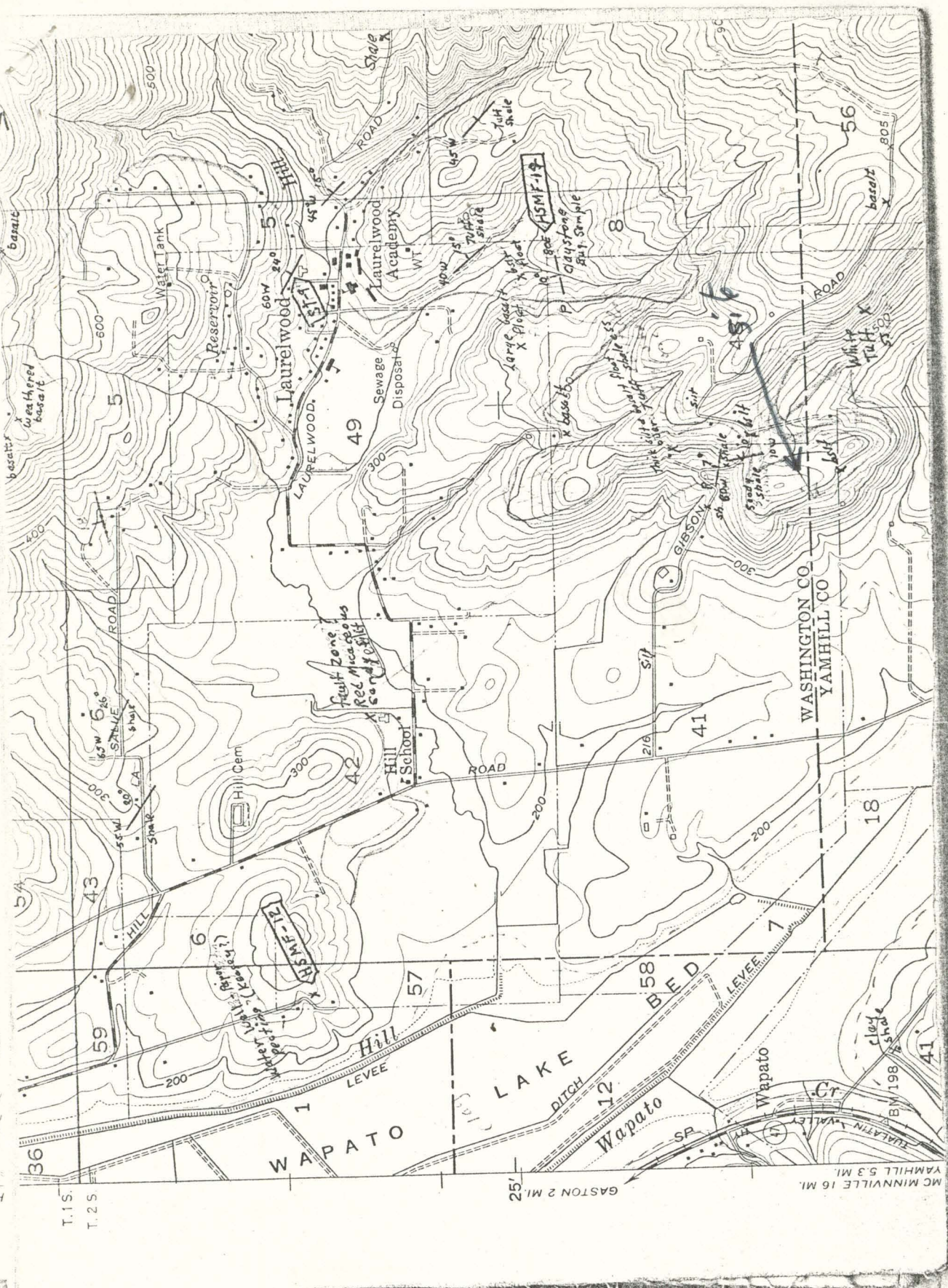
Since good quality rock sources are scarce we would recommend this site be given primary consideration.
