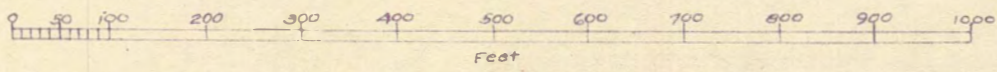

May 1, 1953, at the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, & 30, on E bdy T. 385, R. 5 W, W.M. Ore., I set off 42° 44' 40" W, on the lot ore; 157° 05' 14" of S.M. dept. 1; on the clear arc of survey solar transit No. 461265 and determine a meridian with the solar attachment. All azimuths of this survey are referred to the true meridian determined by continuous solar observations. All measurements of this survey are made with a Dietgen steel tape 300 ft in length.
