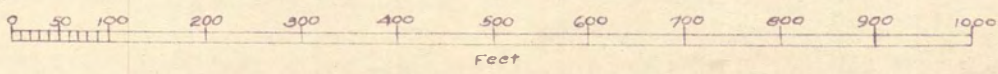

May 1, 1953, at the cor. of Secs. 19, 24, 25 & 30, on E bdy T. 385, R. 5 W., W.M., Ore., I set off 42° 14' 40" N, on the lat. arc; 15° 08' 1/2" N, at 8 a.m., app. T., on the decl. arc of Gurley Solar Transit No. 461265 and determine a meridian with the solar attachment. All azimuths of this survey are referred to the True Meridian determined by continuous solar observations. All measurements of this survey are made with a Dietzgen steel tape 500 ft. in length.
