#### Dredging in 1903

One of the first financially successful dredges was built and operated by the Champlin Electric Gold Dredging Company of Chicago which purchased the Champlin Placer on Footh Creek in 1903. This was a bucket type dredge and operated with steam power, but in November, 1905,

#### State's Chrome Here

During times of national emergency or chrome mines have supplied some of the high grade chromium ore necessary to the country's ferro-alloys industry. Josephine County leads in the state's chrome production and the Oregon Chrome Mine in the Illinois River district is the state's

largest in southwestern Oregon. Our serpentine is searched for in chrysotile asbestos, other common rock spar for ceramic tiles, iron ore for garnet for abrasives; graphite, from schists; pumice from altered rock granules from the rocks are some additions to our

minerals in Oregon.
