

Waldo Mining District to meet

A general meeting of the Waldo Mining District is set for Wednesday at 7 p.m. at the County Building in Cave Junction. Agenda items include a discussion of continued efforts to get the current two-year mineral segregation and the proposed 20-year mineral withdrawal canceled.

There will also be discussion of the Siskiyou National Forest's proposed environmental impact statement concerning suction dredging, the building of a Waldo Mining district panning booth, and the district's participation in Oregon's "Adopt-a-River" program.
