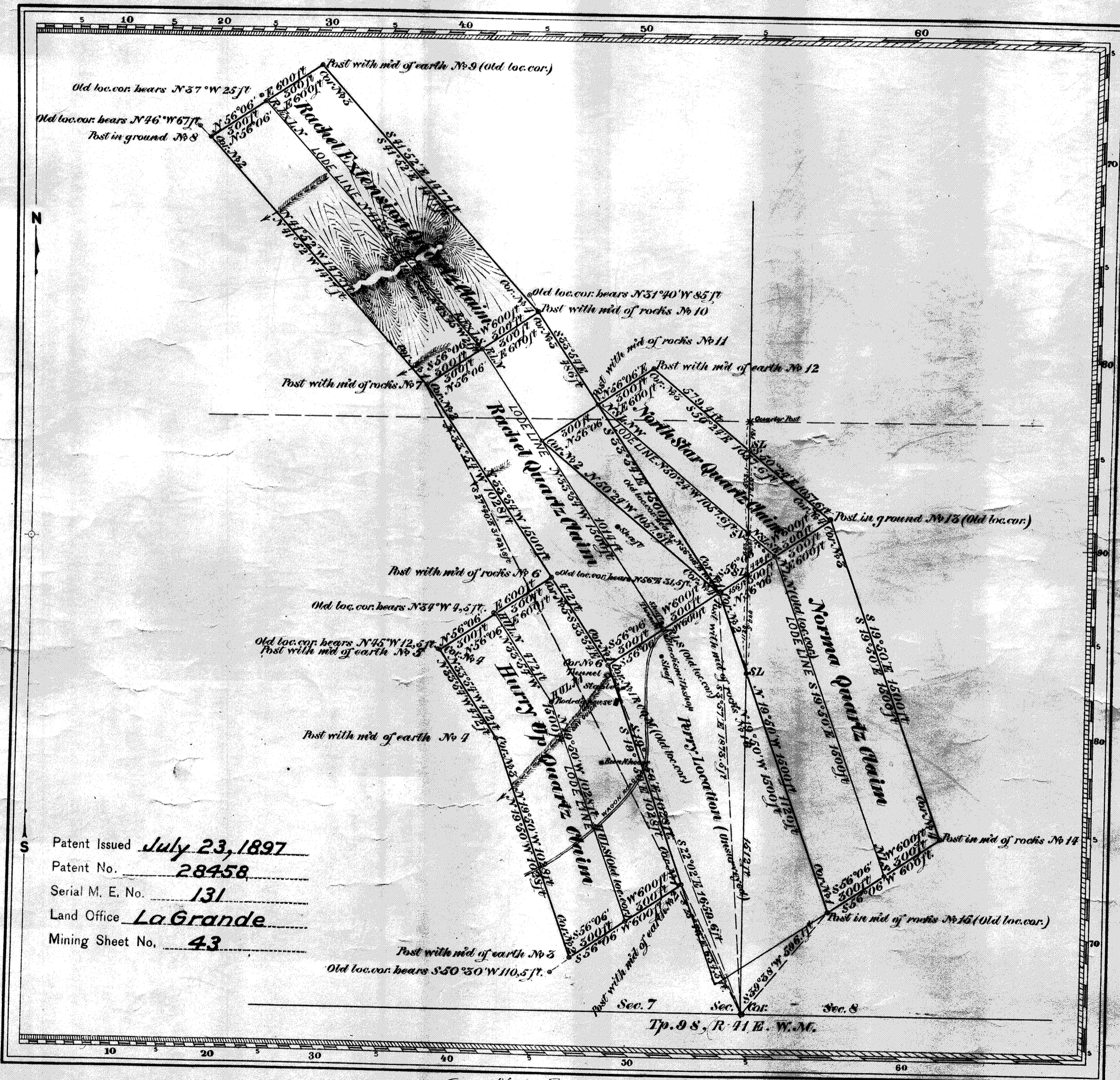

 I further certify that Five Hundred Dollars worth of labor has been expended or improvements made upon said Mining Claim by claimants or their grantors, and that said improvements consist of: 1 Tunnel 570 ft \$1850, Hoise 60 ft \$300, Winze 20 ft \$100, Shaft 170 ft \$1700, Skajthouse \$150, Wire rope and trichets \$150, Blacksmithshop \$50, Boardinghouse \$200, Brickhouse \$50, Stable \$25, Floured 25 ft \$125, Total \$4700, that the location of said improvements is correctly shown upon this plat, and that no portion of said labor or improvements has been included in the estimate of expenditures upon any other claim.  
 And I further certify that this is a correct plat of said Mining Claim made in conformity with said original field notes of the survey thereof, and the same is hereby approved.
