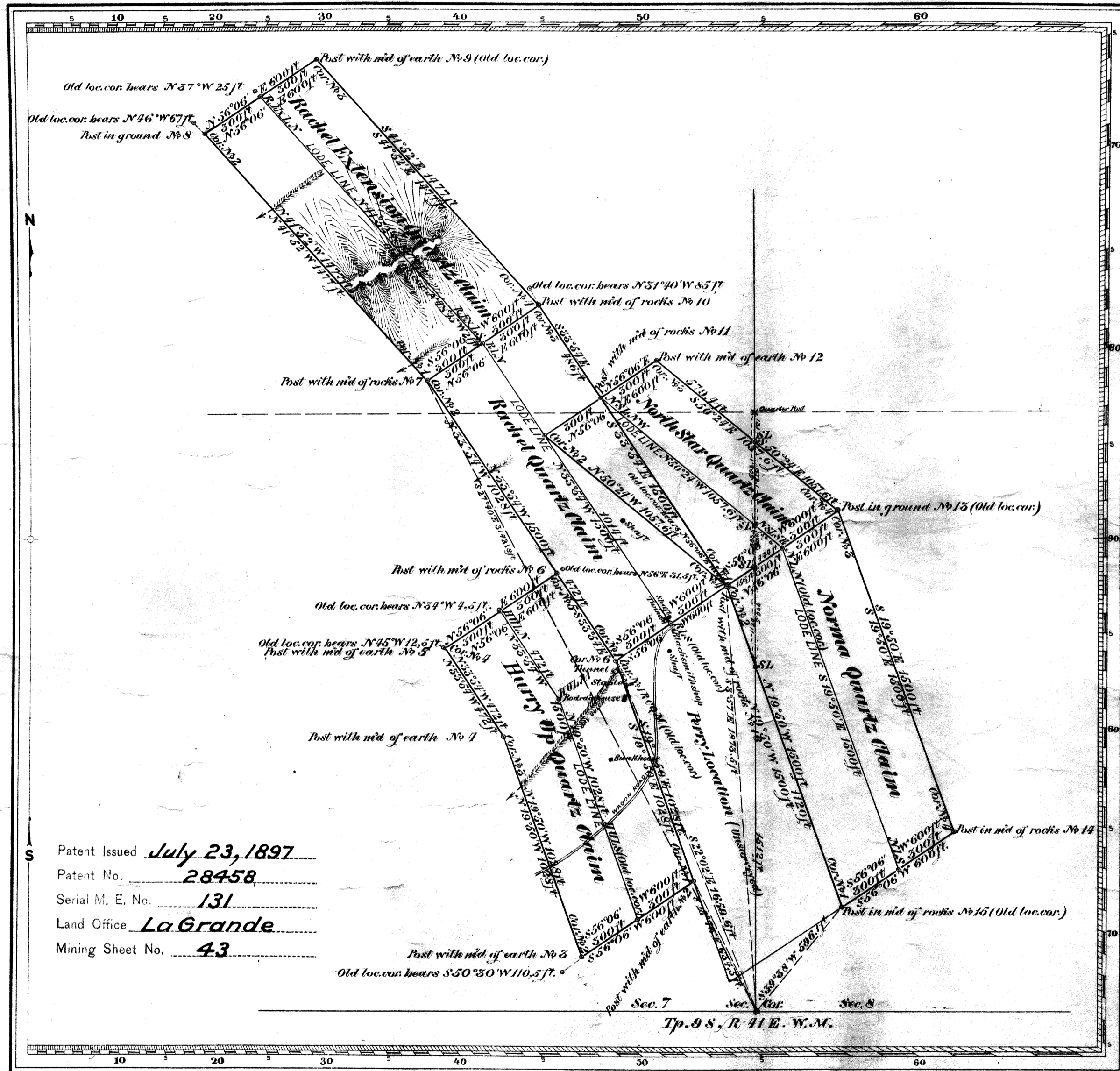

 \$500, Winze 20 ft \$100, Shaft 170 ft \$1700, Shaft house \$150,
