



*(Gold-barite)* MAGPIE MINE

BAKER

DISTRICT: Is 3 miles from shipping point, Haines, on the Old Oregon Trail and the Union Pacific. Located in 1937 and consists of a group of 5 unpatented lode claims, recorded in Baker county. Located in a hilly area; country rock is greenstone and porphyry; vein strata bearing southwest and northeast; width 12 feet, length 3000 feet. Mineral is gold, assayed at \$18. Water is ample from springs; power is available from the Eastern Oregon Light and Power Company nearby; timber not available. No surface equipment and only surface cuts and an 18-foot shaft are developed. In addition to gold values found, there is ~~a~~ *barite* quantity of barium. Owners are Charles Dunn and others, Baker, Oregon. (Prescott---6/1/37).
