Zimmerman Prospect

Baker District

Baker County

Location: NW $\frac{1}{4}$  section 17, T 9 S, R 39 E, on Hubbard Gulch,  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile above the forks of the creek. An. 3940 to 3980'.

Area: The NE $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 17, and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 16.

Development: Numerous open cuts along the vein for 200 feet; about 200 feet of tunnel work.

History: Old open cuts made many years ago. Much of the tunnel work done in the last year or so. No production recorded.

Geology: The country rock consists of more or less altered and silicified greenstone, possibly an old lava or gabbroid rock. Vein strikes from N25 to 45 degrees W, dipping from 45 to 55 degrees to the SW. Steeper in its westward bends. The vein consists of from 4 to 12 inches of red ocherous gouge containing small fragments of quartz. Values are small, up to \$10.00 in gold.

Miscellaneous: The property can be reached to within a quarter mile by road. Water and timber are sufficient for a small operation. Climate moderate to severe, season from April to December.
