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## CROWN POINT

### CABLE COVE

DISTRICT: Is 11 miles from shipping point, Sumpter, on the Sumpter Valley Railway. Located in 1930, and consists of 3 lode claims, recorded in Baker county. Located in high mountain area; country rock is granite and diorite; vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; width 4 feet, length 3000 feet. Minerals are gold and silver, assays at \$12. Water is ample; power is available from the Eastern Oregon Light & Power Company, nearby; timber on claims. Mine is now idle, and no equipment on property. Developed by 1800 feet of tunnels. One of the owners is Otto Simon, Baker, Oregon. (Prescott---6/1/37).
