Pockets have been found on this property and also on similar veins in the region. However, such production as has been made from this rathole is an unknown quantity with the evidence at hand indicating that the value of this production is small as compared to the volume of inderground workings made in order to recover it. Thus, while by the present course of blind development, an operator might stumble on a bunch of ore, after but little work, it is also pessible (and probable) that a large sum of money could be easily expended for the recovery of but modest return. I frankly told King and Sullivan these, My conclusions, and in about as many words, with the added recommondation that they quit their blind daimond drilling in favor of re-opening the old workings for the burpose of making them available for examination. They concurred in this conclusion and 1 understand, began the re-opening job before pulling out for the winter. I know they contacted Firrel Anderson, M. E. about engaging his services in the Spring. Continued work on this tunnel, including two exploratory raises and some diamond drilling, was performed by the present operators. Geology

The crosscut under consideration here is the same crosscut mentioned in the 14A report. The objective in continuing it was to expose one of the main veins of the old workings which was believed to have extended through the area now opened by the recent development. No new vein of apparent consequence was exposed by this recent work, nor has other conclusive evidence been revealed to further establish the relationships between veins previously exposed in this coosscut to those existing in the old workings.

The old workings are at present inaccessible (but the main tunnel is presumably caved at the portal only). Further, there is no geologic map covering the conditions existing in these workings. Although a survey plan of the workings as such exists, differences in opinion also exist as to the correct interpretation in connection with the location and degree of inclination of one or more underground inclines which reportedly occursed which are not clearly distinguished on the map from the drifts and crosscuts. Thus, little data exists on which to make a positive tie-in between the geology of the tunnel and that of the old workings, and accordingly until the old workings are made available for geologic study and re-survey, the potentialities of the crosscut in terms of developing new ore remains problematical.

Is 7 miles east from shipping point, Pondosa, Ore., on a branch of the Union Pacific, and 32 miles from Baker, Ore. A secondary highway from Baker to Medical Springs. Mine was located many years ago, and consists of 7 lode unpatented claims, recorded in Baker county, and 40 acres of deeded timber land. Located in high mountain area; country rock is diorite, hanging wall of granediorite, footwall of diorite; vein strata bearing northwest and southeast; width 8 fnches, length undetermined. Mineral is gold, assays at \$8 to \$50. Water ample; power generated at mine from water wheel; timber on claims. Two men are developing at present. There is one shop, 2 cars and 1000 feet of tunnels.
