Is 21 miles northeast from its shipping point, Baker, Oregon, on the Union Pacific and Old Oregon Trail. The mine was located 45 years ago by the then Judge T. C. Burke, later of Portland, and consists of a group of 6 patented lode claims, 200 acres of timber land and 80 acres of townsite, all platted out and on record in Baker county. Located in a hilly area; the country rock is diorite and greenstone festivals; vein strata is east and west; width 12 feet to 30 feet, length 5000 feet. Minerals are copper, gold and silver; assays at \$1 to \$4. Water is ample from creek; timber on claims; power 3 miles away. Mine is now idle no surface equipment is left, but was developed with a double compartment shaft 400 feet deep. Mine is on same zone as the Balm Creek Gold Mine, about 6 miles west. No doubt it will be a producer if started again. Owner is Frank DeKlois, Filer, Idaho. (Prescott--6/1/37).
