Engle Creek West

Is about 81 miles northeast from its shipping point, Baker, Oregon, on the Union Pacific and the Old Oregon Trail, and was first located 40 years ago. It consists of a group of unpatented lode claims, recorded in Baker County. Located in a hilly area, the country rock is greenstone and porphyry, with hanging walls of greenstone and porphyry footwalls; vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; width from 50 feet to 300 feet. Minerals are gold, copper, and silver; assays at \$3 to \$6 per ton. Mine is active and is equipped with compressor, cars, track, power drills, shop, camp and tools for all purposes. Developed with two shafts, tunnels, and open cuts. Considered one of the best showings in the gold-copper belt. Mine is just west of the Baker Creek mine on Clover Creek. Owner is J. A.
