EAST EAGLE DISTRICT:

Is 43 miles northeast from shipping point, Baker, Oregon, on the Union Pacific and Old Oregon Trail. Mine was located in 1900 and consists of 10 unpatented claims, recorded in Baker county. Located in a high mountain area; the country rock is andesite and granite; vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; 1 foot to 5 feet wide, 4500 feet long. Mineral is gold, assays at \$12. Water is ample; has water power and timber on claims. Equipped with 10 stamp mill and all mining tools. Developed with several hundred feet of tunnels. Mine is now idle. Owner is Mrs. A. Whitaker, Baker, Oregon. (Prescott---6/1/37).
