DISTRICT: Is 4-1/2 miles from shipping point, Weatherby, on the Union Pacific and Old Oregon Trail. Mine was located about 5 years ago, and consists of a group of several claims, recorded in Baker county. Located in a hilly area; country rock is granite; vein strata is a true fissure vein bearing north and south; width 3 feet, length 2000 feet. Mineral is gold; mill run lists are at \$40 to \$60 per ton. Water is scarce; milling power is developed by gas (20 h.p.) engine; timber from government land 3 miles away. Mine is in operation with two men employed. A 5-stamp mill is being erected. Owners are M. P. Gifford and John E. Johnson, Huntington, Oregon. (Prescott---6/1/37).
