Location:  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile up Porcupine Creek from Modine Creek in  
the S. half of sec. 9, T. 11 S., R. 44 E.

The only tunnel on this property intersects at 55 feet a  
narrow vein striking north 60 east and dipping  $80^{\circ}$  to the north.  
This vein showed some value in gold. In the past a much flatter  
dipping vein, striking north 45 west, dipping  $40^{\circ}$  to the southwest,  
has been stoped for 50 feet. This vein lies in decomposed rhyolite  
with much hematite, limonite, and manganese oxides. Country rock is  
also in places argillite and limestone. There is no water available  
and the values from the assays taken were small.
