DISTRICT: Is 20 miles southwest from shipping point, Durkee, on the Old Oregon Trail, via Rye Valley, and Union Pacific. Consists of 10 lode and one placer claim; country rock is diorite and schist; and has a strike of northwest and southeast. Vein is 8 feet wide and 400 feet in length. Mineral is gold, assay value of \$10 per ton. Has a past production of \$16,000. There are 1750 feet of tunnels. Located in 1918 by J. B.
