- Foreword:** This report supplements the account given in Dogami 14A to the extent of listing a subsequent operation and giving the present ownership.
- Owner:** The New Paymaster Mining Company, c/o N.D. Bard, Stanfield, Oregon.
- Area** The property consists of eleven unpatented lode claims as follows; The Mono, Yankee Girl, Ivy Queen, Red Jacket, Liberty, Garfield, Paymaster, I.X.L., Wild Cat, Buckeye and Virginia.
- General:** This company carried on operations on this property, including a short mill run, during part of the years 1939 and 1940. Raleigh Chadwell was in charge of operations. The property has been inactive since the above date.
- Economics:** The production from the above mill run totaled 24.48 ounces in gold after melting according to a Mint Report dated July 11, 1940. Fineness given was 681 $\frac{1}{2}$ gold and 221 silver.

DISTRICT: Is 18 miles southwest from shipping point, Durkee, on the ~~Union Pacific and Old Oregon Trail~~. Mine was first located 35 years ago in Lost Basin and was known as the Reagan Mine. Consists of 12 lode claims, recorded in Baker county. Located in high mountain area; country rock is diorite and serpentine; vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; width 2-1/2 feet, length ~~3000 feet~~. Mineral is gold, assays at \$8. Water from tunnel; power from 50-horse gas engine. Has a 5-stamp mill, 2 ore cars, concentrating table, and light mining tools. There are 2000 feet of tunnels, shaft 250 feet ~~standard size~~. Being operated by Roy Chadwell. (Prescott---6/1/37).
