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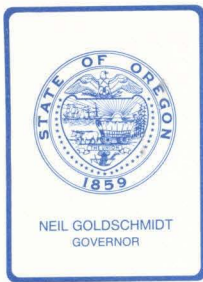

BULL OF THE WOODS MINE

ROCK CREEK DISTRICT:

Is 15 miles southwest from shipping point, Haines, on the Union Pacific and Old Oregon Trail. Mine was located several years ago and consists of one unpatented lode claim, recorded in Baker County. Located in a high mountain area, the country rock is argillite and granite with hanging walls of argillite, footwalls of granite; vein stratabearing northeast and southwest, width, 25 feet. Mineral is silver and gold, assayed at \$5. Water is ample, power available from Eastern Oregon Light and Power Company, nearby. Mine is being developed at present; has 70 feet of tunnels.
