BAISLEY DISTRICT:

Is 14 miles northwest from shipping point, Baker, on the Union Pacific and Old Oregon Trail. Located in 1886 by the owner, and consists of one patented claim, recorded in Baker county. Located in a high mountain area; country rock is granite and argillite; vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; width 4 feet, length 1500 feet. Minerals are gold and silver, assayed at \$10 per ton. Water is ample; power can be had from the Eastern Oregon Light & Power Co. Mine is idle, no equipment. Has 150 feet of tunnels. Joins Baisley mine on the northeast. Owner is Mose Fuchs, Baker, Oregon.
