It is also reported that *D. M. Kelly*, or *Baker*, has a silver claim in argillite, just east of the Johnson claim, upon which there is 1,400 feet of development in 4 adit drifts, in which there are considerable bunches of \$20 to \$60 silver ore.

Prescott, 6/1/37---Is 17 miles southwest from shipping point, Haines, on the Union Pacific and Old Oregon trail. Mine was located 55 years ago and consists of a group of 5 lode unpatented claims, recorded in Baker County. Located in a high mountain area, the country rock being granite with hanging walls of argillite and granite foot, the vein strata bearing northeast and southwest; width, 6 feet, length 4500 feet. Mineral is silver and gold, assayed at \$6. Water ample, power available from the Eastern Oregon Light and Power Co., nearby. Mine is now idle; it is equipped with camp buildings, shop, car, track, hand mining tools. Developed with 2000 feet of tunnels. Owned by Mrs. Mary G. Kelly, Baker, Oregon. *Also daughter & 2 sons.*
