I had little trouble in getting in touch with your brother and examined your property on May 8th. This Department usually does not give the owner of the property a formal report, however a copy of this report is being included as it saves repeating the information.

The assay results of the sample I made is attached. This sample was taken in the cut above the tunnel and in my opinion represents the best manganese in the place. You will note that manganese is low and insolubles including silica is very, very high. I seriously doubt if this property would ever be made commercial.


Dear Mr. Guerin:
