

J. A. Stankovich of Bandon, Oregon, reports that he and his associates are consolidating their holdings with some other claims in the Johnson Creek district, making a total of 12 claims. Development of a pyrrhotite blanket vein at the base of Bald Eagle Butte and construction of a dam to facilitate placer operations for the recovery of copper and gold will be the first undertaking of the group. A three-mile truck road may be built from the highway to the claims. A temporary organization has been formed with E. C. Roberts of Myrtle Point acting chairman.
