possible. At the present time they have no road to the property. Their engineer, Mr. Bob Harrison, is surveying a right of way to Joina Flat on the Coquille River where they will connect with the Forestry road to Powers. After the completion of the road I see no reason why the ore cannot be mined and milled very economically. Mining is to be done with a gasoline shovel which is yet to be purchased. Milling cost when the bugs are taken out of the mill should be low. The gold is fairly course.
