While in Washington yesterday conferred with Mr. McEwen concerning the loan. He advised that Mr. Aaron Waters had been instructed by airmail to conduct an examination of the mine and it was his opinion that he should be in receipt of a report not later than September 15th.

I further questioned him concerning the present demand for mercury and he advised that if the company so wished they could have a contract to sell their entire output at \$192.00 a flask, in New York, and that he had sent these forms to Col. Maller.

He remains firm in his stand concerning the loan, claiming that the application in its present form could not receive the WPB recommendation. This is predicated upon the basic point that the application does not show that there is ore which will be productive of a sufficient amount of mercury to justify the loan. Furthermore, the production record of the mine does not enhance our contention.

Nixon's decision in disqualifying himself to act on behalf of the WPB has caused McEwen to feel that probably a marginal or a border line question is presented and that in view of this fact, Nixon does not want his friendship with Maller to affect his opinion. I attempted to persuade McEwen from this line of thinking.

Do not get the impression that McEwen is hostile



as I do not feel that this is the case. His position is the same as I have previously reported. It might be possible that the report of Waters will be favorable to us.

I then spoke with McEwen concerning the time element which would necessarily be involved in obtaining this loan with the exertion of every possible effort. He explained that if our file was completely in order it would take at least two months and a possible three months.




