

"Nine claims south of Agness and north of Lawson Creek were visited. Four of these lie in a line trending almost south from Agness and continuing into the Game Lake group. Four others make up a similar line four miles long, lying about two and a half miles to the west of the first. These lie in T.35 and 36 S., and R.11 and 12 W.

"All the deposits appear in zones of sheared green talcose serpentine. Irregular areas of dark brown serpentine with a pitchy lustre, and thin lenses of white siliceous magnesite are frequently found near the deposits. In five of the localities the contact of the serpentine with greenstone, schist, sandstone, or dacite porphyry was within 200 yards of the deposits. At two localities the chromite, besides occurring in small high-grade bodies was found in narrow seams in the zone, as well as disseminated through more massive porcellaneous serpentine nearby".
