Dear Mr. Littrell:

We have revised the 1960 file report on the M C Mine and are enclosing a copy for your information.

To date the deposit appears to be somewhat of a "teaser" in that very good gold values are sometimes obtained by sampling, but the results of bulk sampling appear to indicate that no large deposit of commercial ore has as yet been discovered. It is my opinion that careful and systematic prospecting by hand-methods may enable the operators to put it on a paying basis as a small high-grade operation by just working the rich shoots.

The surrounding area is known to be mineralized and some fairly good placer deposits have been worked on the Little Chetco, Ditch Creek, Carter Creek and especially across the divide in the head waters of Canyon Creek. It is an area where further prospecting appears to be justified.
