Location: On west face on the south peak of Saddle Mountain, and is thought to be in Sec. 27, T. 32 S. R. 10 W.

Informant did not visit this property but the owner gave the following information on his property:

"This property consists of the Paradise Claim which was located July 1, 1936. Do not know anything about the prior history of the mine. There are now three tunnels instead of the one described on Page 78 in the Preliminary Survey of Geology and Mineral Resources of Curry County, Oregon. About 100 feet vertically above the one described is another tunnel running parallel and about 150 feet long. A third which is about 100 feet vertically above the second tunnel is one about 45 feet long. The vein shows in both of these tunnels. Other than the above there is no change in this property. No equipment on it. It is very steep mountainous topography. The lower tunnel makes a small amount of water, but not enough for mining or milling.

The last four miles to property, the trail is very steep."
