Mr. Lewis ran a sample of limestone from the Byron property in January, 1940 and reports 88.2 per cent calcium carbonate. On the chip sample which I brought back he reports 66.3 per cent calcium carbonate and 5.8 insoluble.

It is my opinion that the sample with the higher lime percentage is more diagnostic than the latter one.
