met ~~with~~ Joe Sautsberry

up Coffee to Texas Gul  
note angular shaled Conglom  
in graywacke Id.?  
on up Texas Gul about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile  
not coarse conglomerate  
with numerous large  
granite & diorite boulders  
as well as many graywacke  
boulders too gte, quartzites,  
siltstone etc

contact between Id graywacke  
and conglomerate appears to  
be nearly parallel to Texas  
Gul.

$\neq$  N45°E, 65°N = Vothan?

Conglom N20 to 30°E dips  
60-70° SE

evidence of old placer  
abundant

(saw tilted woodpecks at mouth T-bed)

up to Russell Gul

at mouth highly shaled siltstone  
shale-graywacke!  $\neq$  NE first

up Russell Gul cabin about  
melted down age 1930's?

placer claim by
