Just a note to pass on the information on the autunite near Shady Cove. According to Hess it is in an altered rhyolite. It is definitely autunite. Radiometric analysis ~~0.015%~~ 0.015 %, chemical assay 0.013 %.

The property belongs to Thomas Hanson, Shady Cove. It is apparently on a ~~22~~ ranch belonging to him. Location is sec. 2, T. 34 S., R. 2 W. That is all the dope I have, except that under a mineral light the stuff looks quite a bit richer than it is due to the very thin flakes of autunite. Hanson claims that he has had assays in the one percent range. Ed Buel took the sample and says it is roughly representative of the rocks in the area .
