Dear Mr. Garrison:

As agreed upon during my visit to your property on Quines Creek during June of this year, attached are the assay results from the reconnaissance samples taken at that time. You will recall that the samples (with the exception of Sample HMI-1-A - taken from your ore pile of vein material) were chipped randomly across the outcroppings of iron-stained and silicified rock that make up the Forget-Me-Not mineralized zone. While some of the results show quite low values in gold and silver, this may be due, in part, to the small size of the reconnaissance-type samples and, in part, to the fact that the obvious vein structures were avoided in the sampling.

When looked at in the light of a large, low-grade gold deposit, I feel that the assay results are encouraging enough to recommend a more comprehensive sampling of the Forget-Me-Not by the Bureau of Mines.

I will try to get back to Quines Creek later this year, probably during the fall, and will look you up then. Be good, and give Mrs. Garrison my regards.
