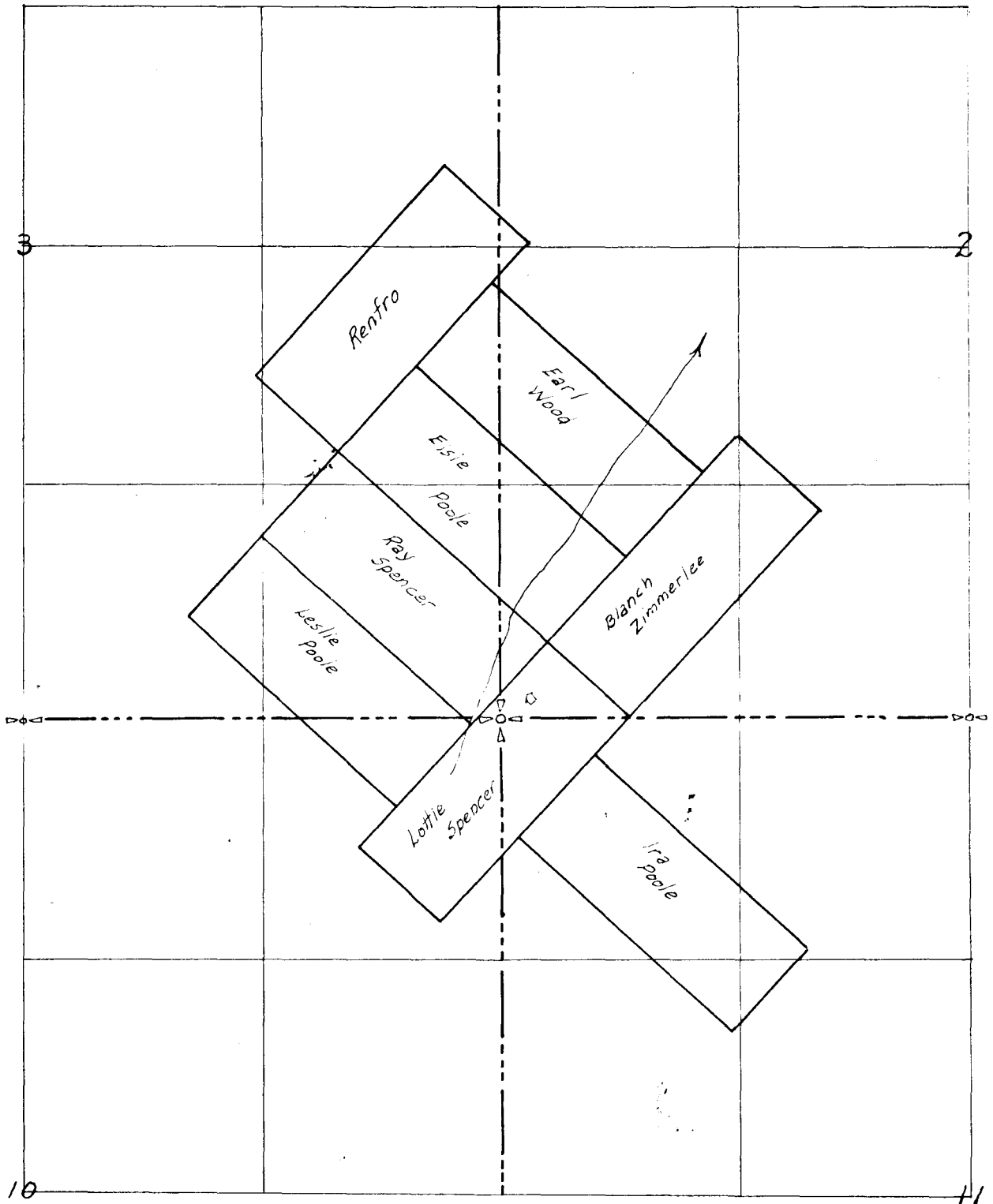


Sketch Map of Cove Sulfur Prospect

sections 2, 3, 10, 11, T. 29 S., R. 3 E. of the Willamette Meridian.

To Castle Rock Creek
(Tributary of S. Umpqua)

Attitude on sulphur vein -
strike, N10W; dip, 30° SW.
S# LG-456 & LG-457 from new
workings. Old cut now being
reopened. Sulphur found in
lenses. Blue clay 4'-5' thick.

Boulders and lenses of sulphur
exposed. Now caved.

Site of old 48' drift, old cut and
some new work. Sulphur found in a
50' long band on an average of 8"
thick. Blue clay 8' thick.

Caved tunnel. One of first workings.
Sulphur found in dump.

Old cut, now caved. Blue clay exposed
15'-20' thick. No sulphur.

No sulphur. Blue clay 8'
thick at face. Old cut,
being reopened. S# LG-455.

No sulphur. Blue clay
4' thick, 12-14' long.
Dug in 37-38'. Now caved.

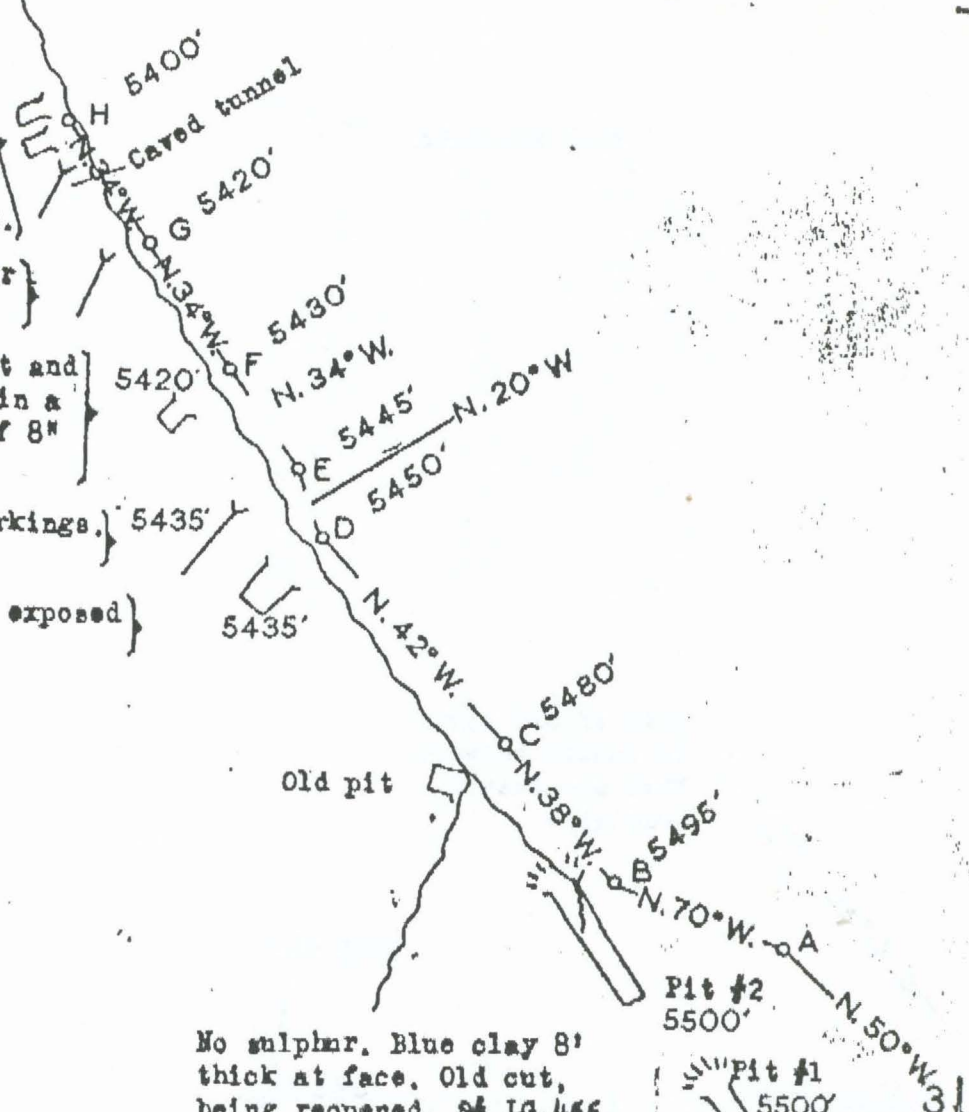


Weaver Mountain

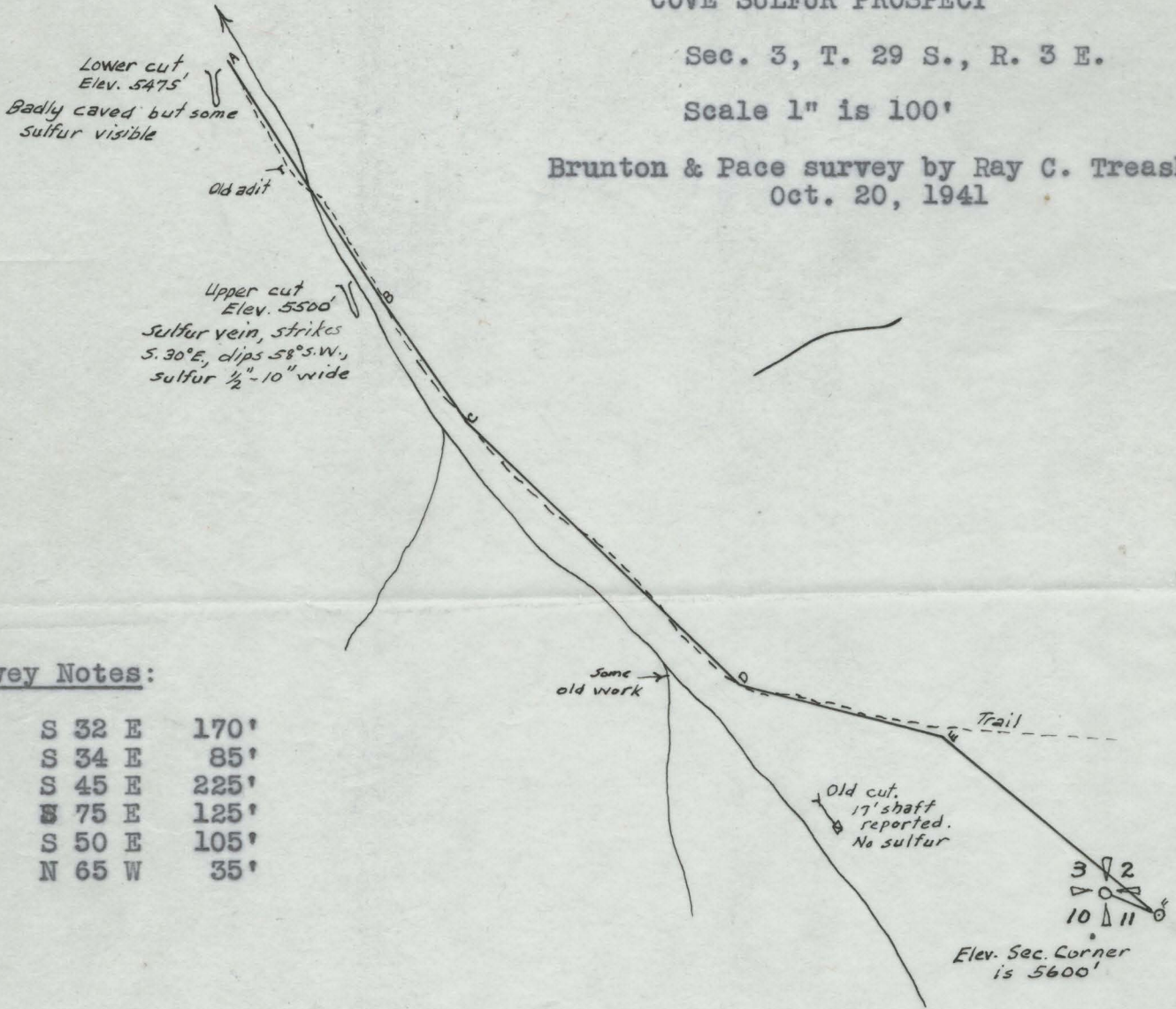
Sketch Map
