1. Type of mine - Unpatented. The discovery proof of any known or potential valuable minerals has not been determined.
2. Size and description of development - A shaft of approximately 7' x 7' x 40' in size; numerous small tunnels and open diggings.
3. Geology - Unknown at this time.
4. History - Only prospecting and assessment activities have been done to date.
5. Source of information - Observations by Forest Service personnel and available Forest Service Steamboat Ranger District records.
