Mr. Richelson of Kennecott Copper visited the office February 13 and reported that the Bureau of Mines was doing some geophysical prospecting in the Queen of Bronze area. He reports that they have found as high as .4 percent nickel in surface holes drilled through 3 feet of soil. Apparently the Bureau also did some geophysical prospecting in the Shamrock mine area north of Rogue River and were able to delineate several ore zones oriented along the strike.
