The **Morrison Mining Company**, headed by H. F. Morrison, 1604 Southeast Thirty-eighth Street, Portland, Oregon, has started placer operations on Cow Creek about 40 miles west of Glendale, Oregon. The company has leased the claims from Ralph Stark. W. H. Peters of Leland, Oregon, is superintendent. While only development work is under way at present, production will be started in the near future. Diesel power is used and the gravel is removed by open pit methods and run over sluice boxes. A pumping plant was recently installed. It is said that four similar operations in the district are planned.
