Diamond trilling is expected to be started soon by the Bureau of Mines at two Oregon chromite properties as the result of recent appropriations by Congress to the bureau for the purpose of investigating and reporting on a number of strategic mineral deposits in the West. The two properties are the Chambers mine east of Canyon City, Oregon, and the Iron-King ground, also located in the Canyon City mining district in Grant County, Oregon. The Chambers mine formerly was worked for gold. Both projects are under the supervision of O. H. Metzger, engineer for the Bureau of Mines, Reno, Nevada.
