MOT CLAIM SPIDER GROUP (chrome)

Grant County
Canyon District

- Location: On the hill directly above the Haggard & New property in T. 14 S.; R. 32 E.; Sec. 16 (about center). A steep access road takes off from the Haggard & New road a few hundred yards below said mine.
- Claims: Spider, Bee, Ridge, Snowbank, and Divide; located in 1954 by Chester Elliott, John Day.
- Lessee: Earl Lyman, in partnership with Kenneth and Gene Lyman and Lyle Calvert. The Earl Lyman address is P. O. Box 432, John Day, Ore.
- General: Some disseminated-type ore was recovered from an exploratory dozer cut during the late fall of 1954 and more is understood to have been mined in early 1955.

This ore, together with a small tonnage secured from other nearby claims, was milled in the Lyman mill in Dog Creek. The concentrates so produced assayed in accordance with the following record taken from the Buying Depot settlement sheets:
