NANCY R (chrome)

Location: T. 14 S., R. 31 E., about Section 30. This property is quite near the old Potatoe Patch mine.

General: J. Kinsella and Jack Shaw mined chrome from here in 1957 and 22.640 dry long tons of concentrates were shipped to the Grants Pass depot. These concentrates assayed only 41.87% Cr_2O_3 and hence were unacceptable. The batch was later sweetened by some 13 tons of concentrates milled from ore from the Gardner Ranch Carlsen property plus about 4 tons of concentrates from ore secured from Diesel Creek. All milling was done at the Al Dunn mill, Canyon City. Depot settlement certificates are not available but the following figures originate from the operators notes and income tax records.
