Ore values are in copper and cobalt with gold. Production is expected in the near future. John R. Van Fleet, 30 East Forty-second Street, New York, is in general charge of mining for the company.

U. S. Vanadium Opens Oregon Cobalt Mine

United States Vanadium Corporation is reported to have started mining operations at the Standard property, a copper and cobalt mine, which was purchased last year. The Standard is located about nine miles north of Prairie City, Oregon, and is not far from the chromite deposits of that district.
