WAYNE STEWART PROPERTY (Chromite)

Grant County

Location: On the South Fork of the John Day River five miles south of the John Day-Dayville highway, in T. 13 S. and probably R. 33 E., but possibly R. 34 E.

Ownership: Deeded ranch land owned by Wayne Stewart.

General: A pod of shipping grade chromite ore was mined from this property by Burt Hayes, John Day, during the summer of 1956, and shipped to the Grants Pass Purchasing Depot, August 9th. Production statistics according to the Purchasing Depot settlement sheet are as follows:
