Davis and Thomas have completed rebuilding their washing plant for dredging on Boulder Creek near Granite.

New trommel, hopper and other parts of Bodinson make were installed. An Atlas Deisel engine on the boat provides the power. A new dragline shovel with 2-cubic-yard bucket will be used to dig the gravel.

Joe Davis and Clarence Thomas installed a plant on the Boulder Creek ground last August but found it too light to do the work. With the heavier equipment they now look forward to a successful operation.
