Equipment: Boat with Bodison trommel 4 feet in diameter and 24 feet long and having 3/8 inch opening. Link Belt drag line with 1 3/4 yard bucket. No. 45 international dozer with 9 foot blade. 35 foot stacker with 30" belt. Truck and other incidental equipment. Power on boat is furnished by 45 HP and 40 HP diesel engines.

Geology: The average depth of bed rock is 10 feet. Most of the gravel is medium and fine. A few boulders are 10" in diameter. There is little or no clay. The yardage is estimated to be 1,750,000 yards.
