

Testing Middle Fork for Gold Dredging

W. H. Cullers and associates of Portland, have taken over contracts for approximately 1200 acres of gold dredge lands on the middle fork of the John Day river. The land lies between the DeWitt ranch and land dredged by the Timms Gold Dredging Company at Galena. The acreage is seven and half miles in length, and includes land belonging to the J. H. Dunstan estate, Oregon Lumber Company, Felix Johnson, Fred Perkins, Bair, Melzer and Brown and J. P. Holland.

Mr. Cullers and associates are interested in the Sumpter Valley Dredging company, and will start a systematic testing of the ground at once.
