

## Custom Mill Treats Ores Near Prairie

The Blankman gold mill on Dixie creek near Prairie City which is operated as a custom mill is reported to be running again after being closed during the winter. Burton Miller has supplied ore for a mill run. A good recovery of value was secured in the free gold with a high grade concentrate which will be shipped to a smelter in Utah.

There are a number of small mines operating in the Dixie creek section which can be worked with a custom plant operating in the district.

The new 25-ton custom mill which the **Mineral Resource Company** is constructing is expected to be in operation within a short time. The plant is located at the Hailey mine on Dixie Creek north of Prairie City, Oregon, in Grant County, owned and operated by L. V. Blankman

of Prairie City, who is also an official of the Mineral Resource Company. Mill feed will be supplied by the Hailey and other mines in the district.
