HISTORY: During the development in 1935-36 a 200 ft. shaft with 200 ft. of drift was driven or was mined and shipped and some was also milled. Previous to that time there had been no development for many years, and the production is not known. The 2 shafts are 50 and 80 ft. deep with drifts of 100 and 75 ft. There are 3 levels, the upper being 250 ft. long, the middle 350 and the lower 750. These are all on one vein and are all caved. The shaft is full of water and the ore is said to have been all stoped to the surface.

EQUIPMENT: Chili type roll mill and 4 x 5 ft. amalgamation plate. Dodge type crusher.
