

WILL TEST ORE

After ten month's work in the Dixie Meadows mine near Prairie City, Nels Speelman completed re-timbering and catching up caved ground in the mine workings early in April. The mine was reopened for Leverett Davis of the Cornucopia Gold Mines for inspection. Ore from the mine will be tested for the purpose of determining the best treatment methods. The ore is complex and when the mine was first developed more than 30 years ago the treatment was one of the causes of closing. —Oregon Mining Review.

For a year sampling the ore at the Dixie Meadows mine 12 miles north of Prairie City has been in progress by the Cornucopia company. The extensive underground workings have been checked. The value of this mine has long been recognized in the vast tonnage of a high grade ore, and with modern methods it probably will in time come into a big production.
