CANYON AREA

Three prospects are situated in the vicinity of Bull Spring, which is near the common corner of sec. 15, 16, 21, 22, T. 15 S., R. 28 E. The workings are in the serpentine that forms a bare ridge northwest of the road between Murderers Creek and the South Fork of Murderers Creek. No chromite besides that forming thin coatings on slickensided surfaces was seen in place, although a few small pieces of slickensided black ore were found on the dumps.
