LOCATION: On Indian Creek, 6 miles ^{south} of Alvord Ranch, about one mile west of the Steens Mountain Mine. workings can be seen from parking place, where cars must be left.

DEVELOPMENT WORK: Development work consists of open cut 4' x 6' x 10' on Last Chance No. 1 claim; open cut 4' x 6' x 18' on Last Chance No. 2 claim. The Indian Chief has a location pit.

REMARKS: This property was not visited. Samples exhibited which were taken from the development workings showed high grade cinnabar. Cinnabar said to occur in narrow high grade stringers.
